When asked your thoughts on the Rake-a-thon the responses reminded us to speak to the students in advance about service and that the communication was improved this year, except the short notice of needing to bring a rake. It was also shared that the amount asked for students to collect was excessive and we should evaluate some new ideas for next year.

When asked about your vision for the school or what you want to see in the coming years, most of the responses mentioned a focus on enrollment efforts to increase class sizes and working to get 6th grade back. There were also comments shared about getting Spanish back and continuing to increase the academic rigor.
