2024-2025 CLUBHOUSE FEES SCHEDULE St. Bartholomew Catholic School

St. Bart's School is pleased to once again offer in-house wraparound care called "Clubhouse". Families may choose a weekly schedule that best meets their needs. Drop-in days are available on a limited basis to families who only need occasional after school care (a minimum of 24 hours notice is requested). Space is limited. We have done our best to keep our fees low and manageable, whether you have four kids or one at St. Bartholomew.

- Clubhouse contracts will be charged to TADS in October. There is an option to spread payments over several invoices. We will work with you!
- \$40 late pick-up fee will be assessed for students picked up after 5:35 pm.
- Drop-in rate for last minute care (i.e. late pick-up from carline) is \$30/day.
- Repeated late pick-ups from carline will result in a meeting with parents to plan for timely pick-up.
- Schedule changes require 2 weeks notice. Changes without notice will result in a \$40 fee.
- Drop-in days will be billed to TADS accounts monthly:

2024-25 St. Bart's Children's Choir Program

This upcoming year, I am excited to build upon the success of last year's first season of the St. Bartholomew Children's Choir. Music has always played an important role in the liturgical life of St. Bartholomew. In keeping with this commitment to an excellent sacred music program, we will be introducing two new children's choirs in place of the one. The Junior choir (grades K-2) will focus on developing vocal technique in our youngest singers. The Treble choir (grades 3-8) will continue to develop vocal technique, as well as be introduced to music theory and sight readings. There will be a strong emphasis on learning a repertoire of music from the immense treasury of sacred music which belongs to the Catholic Church. Rehearsals will be weekly for both choirs.
